**Pipeline removal – Corpus Christi Ship
Channel near beacons 25/26**

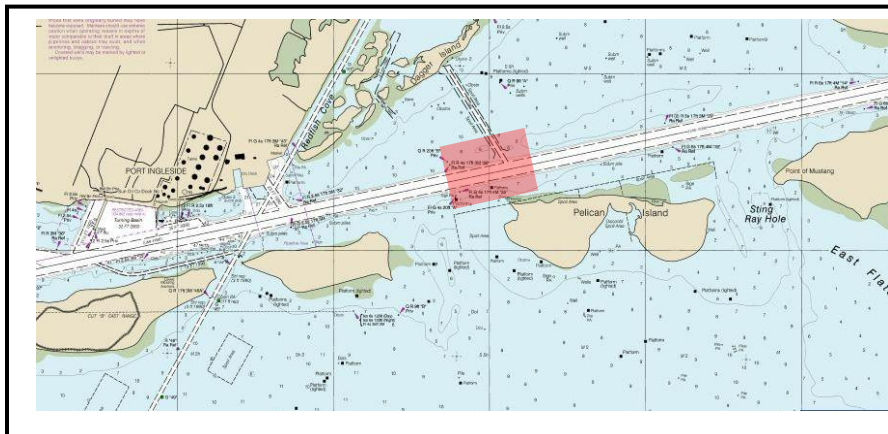

The Captain of the Port is rescinding the safety zone in the Corpus Christi Shipping Channel on Tuesday, June 14, 2022 between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.

The Captain of the Port will establish a safety zone in the Corpus Christi Shipping Channel from Wednesday, June 15, 2022 through Friday, June 17, 2022, between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. daily. Boundaries of the safety zone will be for all navigable waters of the Corpus Christi Shipping Channel in a rectangular zone defined by the following coordinates: 27°49'00"N, 097°10'34"W; 27°49'17"N, 097°13'42"W; 27°49'28"N, 097°09'52"W; 27°49'12"N, 097°09'49"W. No vessels 500GT or larger shall transit through the safety zone without permission from the U.S. Coast Guard. Inland barges and associated tugs and vessels less than 500GT will be able the transit the safety zone by making passing arranges with the MISS ROSE and RAYMOND.

The M/V MISS ROSE and RAYMOND will be monitoring VHF channels 12, 16 and operating on channel 19.
